HOW TO PARTICIPATE

- 1. Attend virtual Birdathon kick-off event March 24th (optional).
- 2. Decide how you'd like to participate (i.e. 24-hour period, the month of April, from your backyard, a trip to Mexico...it's up to you!).
- 3. Have one team member register and create a fundraising page with the team name, a photo, fundraising goal, and team blurb.
- 4. Promote by sharing your fundraising page with friends and family. Link it on social media and tag us.
- 5. Go birding and track the number of species you see.
- 6. Report back to Tucson Bird Alliance and your donors by May 9th.
- 7. Attend the wrap-up party May 20th to celebrate and win prizes!

Note: A team can be an individual or as many people as you'd like!

HOW TO WIN

Big Day

Count as many individual species as possible within a 24 hour period. High species count wins!



New to Birdathon? Here's a category for you! Judged by a panel of honorary judges loosely using Grand Champ criteria.

Birdathon Beyond AZ Support our fundraising and conservation efforts from afar. Judged by a panel of honorary judges.

Grand Champions

Best all-around effort including # species, funds raised, and uniqueness. Judged by a panel of honorary judges.

Best Bucks for Birds

Aim high! Awarded to the team who raises the most money.

HOW TO SUPPORT





Total = pledge amount x number of species observed

Example:

- 1. You pledge \$1 per species for Team A
- 2. They report 50 species during Birdathon
- 3. You donate \$50 to Team A

Give a fixed amount anytime during Birdathon

Example:
